

'Little Memories of Melbourne' is a project to keep Melbourne residents connected and inspired during this period of social distancing.

We hope that hearing memories of what makes Melbourne special will entertain and uplift people, and that putting memories up in windows will create a trail of community connection. The collection of memories will be used as inspiration for a poetry film by a local writer, and may also inspire a range of other creative engagement too!

Anyone can join in. All you have to do is share a memory of a particular place in Melbourne that is special to you. Write a line about the place and experience you remember (and what makes it special), then put it up in your window and, if you can, share it on our Memories of Melbourne Facebook page . You can also post your memories through the letterbox at the Arts Melbourne Gallery in the Market Place, where we will be creating a display for the window.

We hope people will get started straight away, and we will continue to share the project until at least the middle of August after which Rebecca will collate the entries and create a finished piece to be displayed in mid-September.
